

Before And After-Care

LCK offers Before and After-care to children enrolled in the LCK 3K or 4K morning program. After-Care will be staffed by a qualified Child Care Teacher as defined in the WI State Licensing Rules.

This program will take place in rooms 101 & 120.

Before-Care Block Info:

The Before-Care program will be used by any 4K student who rides a North Lake bus to school or any 3K/4K student who needs care before their preschool class begins. 4K children riding the bus will be met by a LCK staff member and signed in. If a parent or authorized escort is bringing their child for Before-Care, they will need to escort their child to room 101 and sign them in. Children may not be dropped off before 7:30 in the morning.

Cost \$5 per day

After-Care will be offered in two time blocks:

- **Short Block: 11:00-12:45pm; Cost \$9**

The short block consists of lunch and center activities.

- **Long Block: 11:00-2:30pm; Cost \$19**

The Long block consists of lunch, gross motor activities, short rest time, center activities, and free play. Children in the long block need a Child Size sleeping bag at rest time.

Policy for Full Time Before and After Care

Full time Before and After Care is defined as follows:

4K- Uses **both** before care Monday thru Friday **and** long block after care Monday thru Friday for the complete LCK school year

3K- Uses **both** before care **and** long block after care for the two days they attend- either Monday/Wednesday or Tuesday/Thursday for the complete LCK school year. Credits do not apply to students that attend class on Fridays. If a student is signed up for the optional third day a credit could be used on a Friday but a credit cannot be obtained for an absence on a Friday.

Students that are full time for 4K as defined above will receive a 10% monthly discount.

If a student is full time as defined above then that student is eligible for a credit of 4 days per LCK school year. The parent/guardian is responsible to submit a request form to receive the credits (forms located in the LCK office, Room 121). The credits will not be carried over or paid out for cash.

Payment:

You will be able to sign up for the block(s) you need on a monthly calendar. Payment is due by the date indicated on the previous monthly calendar.

*Please note September's calendar **and** payment is due **before** the first day of school.*

Lunch Details:

Each child should bring a lunch from home to eat in room 120. Milk will be provided by the school. All lunches must meet the U.S Department of Agriculture Child Care Food Program minimum meal requirements. These can be found in the LCK Preschool Parent Handbook. All Families will receive this handbook at Parent Orientation. LCK staff will sit with children while they eat to help facilitate socialization and aide them during lunch.

Extended Care Provided by North Lake School:

The LCK After-Care program collaborates with North Lake School's extended care/tutoring program for our 4K program. Any 4K child needing care after 2:30pm will be escorted to the North Lake Extended Care Program. North Lake's fees are in addition to LCK's After-Care fees. Please contact North Lake office with questions; 262-966-2033.

School Closing:

If North Lake/LCK is closed due to inclement weather, emergency, etc. This program will be closed as well. LCK Before and After-Care will not be available on days North Lake has early dismissal/half days or non-student days. LCK Before and After-Care will end in May on the last day of 4K.

We will have time during the Parent Orientation for further details and questions. September calendars will also be distributed at this time, if you want to take advantage of this program.
